

An Awareness programme on '*Enduring Legacy of Mahatma Gandhi in the 21st Century*' in collaboration with St. Pauls Cathedral Mission College, Kolkata (26.09.2024)

Gandhiji and Kasturba Gandhi were warmly felicitated by the students of St. Pauls Cathedral Mission College, Kolkata in 1915. The Department of Political Science and IQAC in collaboration with Gandhi Smarak Sangrahalaya organized an Awareness Programme on the '*Enduring Legacy of Mahatma Gandhi in the 21st Century*' at the college campus on September 26, 2024.

In this context the staff members of the Sangrahalaya reached at St. Pauls Cathedral Mission College campus and two separate temporary exhibitions, viz. '*From Mohan to Mahatma*' (A pictorial exhibition on Life and Philosophy of Mahatma Gandhi) and '*India of My Dreams*' (Gandhiji's constructive programmes for redevelopment of the society) were temporarily setup at there. The students of the college showed the exhibition first. Followed by a Welcome Address was delivered by the Principal of the college and a special lecture on the relevance of Gandhiji was delivered by the Head of the Department of History.
