

School Programme for Schools in the Remote Areas

As part of its Mobile Exhibition and daylong programme for schools in the remote areas a team from the Sangrahalaya visited Bagbagan, B.M. High School at Gosaba in the district of 24 Parganas South on May4, 2017. The mobile exhibition set *Alokchitre Teen Mahajibon* (three great personalities in photographs- Gurudev Rabindranath Tagore, Mahatma Gandhi and Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose) in roll-up standee was mounted at the school premises. After this the documentary titled *Role of Barrackpore in the Freedom Movement of India* was shown to the students which was followed by the audio-visual quiz consisting of twenty (20) questions on life and activities of Mahatma Gandhi. The documentary prepared by the institution **Juktibadi Sanskritik Samsthha**, Canning, titled *Snakes of Sunderban* was presented by the Sangrahalaya in the second half of the programme in the section called *Deshher Kathha Dasher Kathha* for highlighting the environmental aspect of nature.
